Luminous Mysteries of the Rosary for children

1. Jesus is baptized by John in the river Jordan

When Jesus is baptized in the Jordan River, the heavens open and the Holy Spirit comes down in the shape of a dove over Jesus. And the voice of the Father in Heaven says: "You are my beloved Son!" Through baptism we also belong entirely to God. We have become Christians. So God says to each of us: "You are my beloved child."

Jesus, we pray to you: May all people come to know that they, too, have a Father in heaven, who loves them infinitely.

2. Jesus reveals his power at the wedding at Cana

The wine has run out. Mary sees what has happened and turns to Jesus for help. And Jesus turns water into wine. It is his first public miracle.

Mary, please help us to be sensitive to people who are in need and be ready to help them. Help us to pray faithfully and to join with you in asking for the needs of others.

3. Jesus proclaims the Kingdom of God

Jesus teaches the people all about God, so that they will learn to live happily and at peace. He calls on everyone: Be converted! For he wants every single person to be able to get to heaven.

Jesus, we beg you: don't let us be deaf to your words when you tell us we must change our lives and be better people.

Please convert all who have hatred in their hearts, or who wage war and destroy the lives of other people.

4. Jesus is transfigured on the mountain top

On the top of Mount Tabor, the disciples of Jesus are given a glimpse of Jesus in his glory. His face shines like the sun and his clothes have grown dazzlingly white, like pure light.

Jesus, we beg you: comfort everyone who is sick or suffering. Let them see that you are always close to them and will one day turn their sorrows into joy. And help us also to make little sacrifices with great joy.

5. Jesus gives himself to us in the Eucharist

In Holy Mass, the greatest miracle of all occurs. At the hands of the priest, Jesus changes the bread into his own Body and the wine into his own Blood. And he permits us to receive him in Holy Communion. He wants to be completely united with us.

Jesus, we ask you, may we become more and more like you, each time we receive you.

Help all the missionaries in the world to bring people to Jesus in the Eucharist, so that Jesus himself can transform them and unite them together in the great community of the Church.
