Amen.



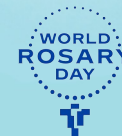

How to pray the Rosary



1. Sign of the Cross
2. Apostles' Creed
3. Our Father
4. Three Hail Marys
5. Glory Be
6. Announce the first Glorious Mystery (The Resurrection of the Lord)
7. Begin a Decade:
-Pray one Our Father
-Pray ten Hail Marys (while meditating on the mystery)
-Pray one Glory Be
-Pray the Fatima Prayer
8. Repeat steps 6 and 7 for the remaining four decades, meditating on a different mystery for each decade.

The sign of the Cross

In the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

The Apostles' Creed

I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; he descended into hell*; on the third day he rose again from the dead; he ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there he will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.

3. Jesus, who sent us the Holy Spirit

The Holy Spirit helps us to understand what Jesus said and did. He shows us what is true and fills us with His love, so that we can love like Jesus.
